

Health Science Technology 1 – A course designed to develop health care specific knowledge and skills in effective communications, ethical and legal responsibilities, client care, safety, first aid, and CPR. This course prepares the student for the transition to clinical rotation.

Health Science Technology 2 – A course designed to provide for the development of multi-occupational knowledge and skills related to a wide variety of health careers. The student will observe and/or assist professional health care personnel in a clinical environment. This class will be a two-hour block, meeting Monday through Friday for the entire school year.

Health Science Technology 3 – An occupationally specific course designed to provide knowledge and skills for certification or licensure in an allied health career. Students develop advanced clinical skills necessary for employment in the healthcare industry. This class will be a two-hour block, meeting Monday through Friday for the entire school year.
