## PURPOSE

To provide an opportunity for students to earn course credit(s) lost during the regular school year.

## REGISTRATION (HIGH SCHOOL)

Ongoing through May 30, 2024. Registration is limited and will be done on a first-come, first-serve basis. Courses taught at Austin Academic Center are online courses.

## LUNCH

If you are staying through the lunch period (11:00-11:15 p.m.), you will need to bring your lunch. There are no cafeteria services during summer school.

## SUMMER SCHOOL CREDIT

Summer school credit is earned by ½ credits, with completion of the fall semester work first, if applicable. Attendance requirements must be met before school credit is assigned.

## ATTENDANCE

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> absence per .5 credit, a student will be dropped from the class roll, and no course credit will be awarded.

## COST

There is **no** cost to the student for a course in summer school which is for credit recovery.

## STUDENT BEHAVIOR

Students are expected to exhibit self-discipline and follow established rules and guidelines outlined in the Student Code of Conduct and Student Handbook. Discipline standards are the same as during the regular school year. Failure to follow discipline standards may result in students being dropped from Summer School.

## DRESS CODE

The dress code for Summer School is the same as that enforced during the regular school year. Please refer to your Student Handbook. Failure to follow dress code standards may result in a student being dropped from Summer School.

## TRANSPORTATION
