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Michael Lamb called the meeting to order. He welcomed those in attendance and thanked them for coming. He reminder members that these meetings are a place to bring any concerns or questions. He opened the floor for any comment. There was none.

Lamb started the process of discussing the 2021-2022 school calendar. He reminded members that days are now counted in minutes and that there has to be a minimum of 420 minutes a day to constitute a full day. This year's calendar will be made up of 450-minute days, with three early release days of 310 minutes. He said the State requires 180 student days and 7 teacher staff prep days. The proposed calendar will use additional waiver days (if granted) and earned minutes for 166 student days and 21 staff prep days. He listed the typical student/staff holidays and the proposed student holidays/staff prep days for 2021-22. The proposed calendar would have a student start date of August 18 and end date of May 25. After more discussion, it was decided that Lamb would send members a copy of the proposed calendar for their review and discussion with their respective campus staff. The council will meet again on Wednesday, March 17 to firm up a calendar proposal to submit to the school board for approval.

Lamb thanked members again for attending and the meeting was adjourned.
