Others Present: Jason Evans

Jason Evans opened the meeting and welcomed those in attendance. He made members aware of two upcoming events. He told the group that they would start work on the next year school calendar at the February meeting. Next, he made members aware of the February 14 board meeting where the Annual Report of Educational Performance/TAPR being discussed at this meeting would be presented to the public. He invited members to attend.

Evans presented the Annual Report and TAPR to members. He reviewed the report in detail. Evans asked for any questions from the group and there were none.

In place of Josh Williams, Evans reviewed the Health and Safety Update for SSISD Safe Return to In-Person Instruction. He noted that the plan is in place to be able to have in-person school due to COVID-19. He said that Williams updated the plan on January 10, 2022. Evans told members that the plan is located on the district website for their further review. He then highlighted several parts of the plan. The floor was opened for any questions or comments. There were none.

Next Evans polled the group regarding the purchase of keyboards for 3rd grade iPads. One of the reasons for the purchase is due to changes that are coming with the STAAR test that will require more typing and to do that on the existing iPads would mean parts of the test content would be hidden while typing directly on the device. He said that there are enough Title I funds at this time to cover the purchase of 350 keyboards at a cost of approximately \$14,000.00. He told members he needed their approval to make the purchase. The group approved for Evans to purchase the keyboards.

Evans then opened the floor for any general questions or comments. There were none and the meeting was adjourned.
