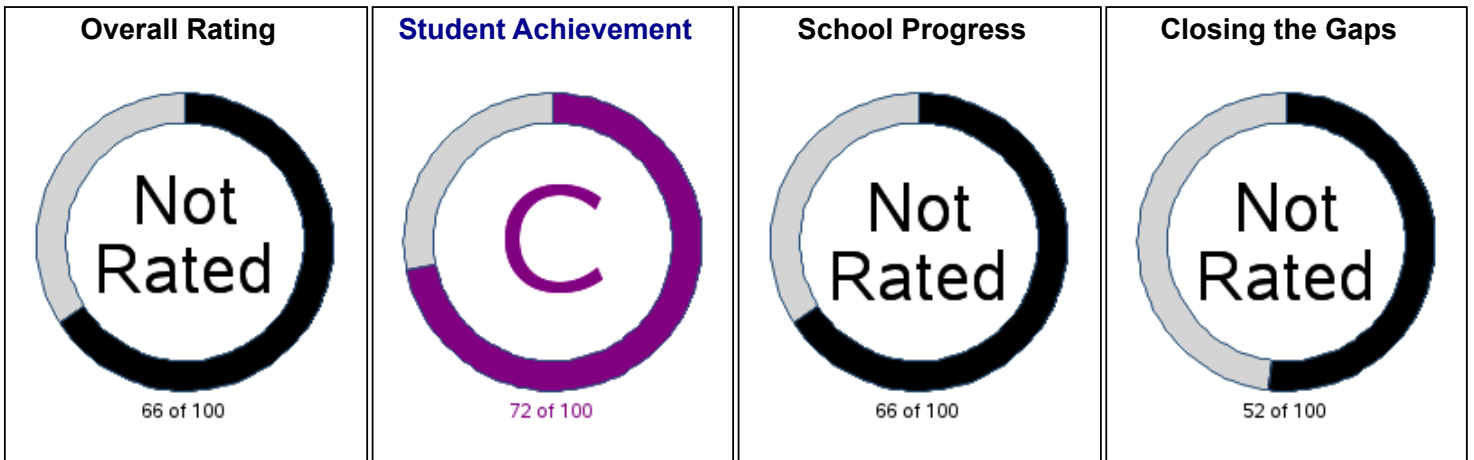

**Overall Performance Details**

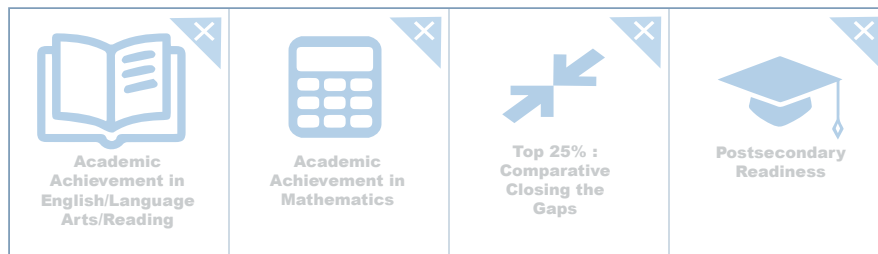

State accountability ratings are based on three domains: Student Achievement, School Progress, and Closing the Gaps. Scores are scaled from 0 to 100 to align with letter grades.

To align with Senate Bill 1365, a Not Rated label is used when the domain or overall scaled score is less than 70.



**Distinction Designations**
